Linden, Virginia -- The Culpeper, Fauquier, Rappahannock and Warren County Democratic Committees announce that they will caucus starting at 2:00 p.m. on Saturday, May 27, 2017 for the purpose of nominating a Democratic candidate for the 18th District of Virginia's House of Delegates.

The 18th Legislative District includes part of Culpeper County consisting of the East Fairfax, Eggbornsville, Jeffersonton, Rixeyville and the Brandy Station Precincts; part of Fauquier County consisting of the Opal, Baldwin Ridge, Courthouse, Airlie, Warrenton, Bealeton, Marshall, Leeds, Waterloo, Springs Valley, The Plains and the Broad Run Precincts; all of Rappahannock County and the part of Warren County consisting of the Happy Creek, Linden, East Shenandoah and the South River Precincts.

The caucus will be held in the Warrenton Community Center, 430 E Shirley Ave, Warrenton, VA 20186.

Any person wishing to be a candidate for nomination for the office listed above must file a Declaration of Candidacy form along with a \$360.00 filing fee with Dee Pendley, Chairman of the 18th District Nominating Committee, 13201 Hazegrov Farm Lane, Linden, VA 22642 prior to 6:00 p.m., April 15, 2017. No person who has failed to comply with the pre-filing requirements may be considered for nomination.

Any person attending the caucus, before participating in that caucus, shall sign a standardized declaration form stating that he or she is a Democrat, does not intend to support any candidate who is opposed to a Democratic nominee in the ensuing general election, and is a registered voter in such precinct or county or city. Declaration forms must be filled out at the caucus prior to voting. Doors will open at 1:15 p.m. and the caucus will begin promptly at 2:00 p.m. at which time the doors will be closed and no person may complete a form or enter after that time with the exception of those persons in line at 2:00 p.m. For further information, please contact Dee Pendley, Chairman, 18th House of Delegates Nominating Committee, (703) 304-6344.

Should no candidate or only one candidate file by the filing deadline, that candidate will be declared the nominee and the 18th District Democratic Nominating Committee may cancel the caucus.
